Card and Slotting Techniques





Vocabulary	
sculpt	To create solid objects made out of a material such as wood, clay, metal or stone.
card and slotting techniques	To use a craft knife or scissors to create gaps in card so that another piece of card can slot into it.
free standing form	Something that stands without a support unit.
observational art	To draw or paint a subject as accurately as possible
natural forms	An object found in nature that has not been changed or altered
