Vocabulary	
sculpt	To create solid objects made out of a material such as wood, clay, metal or stone.
malleable	Capable of being shaped.
slip	Particles of clay in water. It is used to bond pieces of clay, to decorate and protect pottery.
Engrave	Cut or carve on the surface of a hard object.
pinch technique	Pinch the clay into the shape desired.
slab technique	Use smooth slabs of clay that are formed around moulds or shaped and cut by hand.
coil technique	Work the clay in the form of ropes, then roll the ropes over each other to create a shape.
