Vocabulary	
abstract art	Artwork that does not attempt an accurate depiction of reality.
dot work	A style of painting created by the dotting of paint.
primary colours	Yellow, blue and red. These colours cannot be created by mixing other colours.
secondary colours	The colour combinations created by equal measure of two primary colours.
tertiary colours	The colour combination made by mixing one primary colour with half of another primary colour.
