We will then be looking at poetry on volcanoes leading up to writing our own.

In Maths this half term, we will be continuing our work on fractions before moving on to **decimals**.

Times tables are <u>extremely</u> important in Year 4, with a 'Times Tables Check' taking place this Summer Term. Please use Times Tables Rockstars as much as possible at home to learn all times tables.

In Science, we will be exploring **Electricity** as it is important the children have a good understanding of circuits and switches for our DT project this half term. We will be learning about **battery and mains** powered objects, switches, circuits, insulators and conductors.



PE is on **Thursdays** this half term. Please wear your school PE kit on this day— plain red t-shirt, navy shorts or trousers and black pumps.

Swimming — We will be going swimming on <u>Wednesdays</u>. Please bring a bag to school that contains a swimming costume/trunks, a towel and goggles if needed.

In DT we will be designing, making and evaluating a lamp.

In **Music**, we will be looking at 'Blackbird' pop music in the style of The Beatles.

In **Computing**, we will be learning about e-safety and how reliable information is on the internet. Children will also be reminded about age appropriate games as these have a lot of damaging effects to pupils when exposed under the age advised.
