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

Vocabulary	
<b>template</b>	A shape drawn to exact shape and size and used to assist cutting out.
<b>stitch</b>	One movement of a needle and thread through a material.
<b>seam</b>	A line of stitching that joins pieces of fabrics together.
<b>appliqué</b>	Describes a method of stitching/gluing patches onto fabric.
