#### **PAFRAS Xmas Gifts**

A message from Evie Russell-Cohen from the PAFRAS organisation. Well done to everyone involved!

I'm writing to express our many thanks for the Christmas gifts that you donated to PAFRAS via Horsforth Town of Sanctuary.

We were able to give them out to the families we work with at our Christmas Drop In. 65 families came to the drop in, and in total we were able to give gifts to 114 children. ## **Headingley & Kirkstall Band**

I have been asked by Mr Robertson, Headteacher at Kirkstall Valley Primary, to inform you that there is an exciting opportunity upcoming for all budding musicians in the area!

'I am writing to invite your school to join us in supporting our band project aimed at providing children across Headingley and Kirkstall with the opportunity to participate in a local brass, wind, keyboard, and percussion band. This initiative builds on an existing band and is designed as a progression route for children who show promise in whole-class music lessons or other musical opportunities, particularly those who may not have access to paid individual lessons.

The band will be open to children from all local schools, ensuring inclusivity and accessibility for all.

We believe this initiative represents excellent value for money, enabling us to offer children a high-quality music outcome which supports their musical development.

To overcome logistical challenges, we propose hosting rehearsals at Kirkstall Valley Primary School, which is fairly central to all schools. We recognise that travel to another school site may remain a consideration for some families, but we are confident that the benefits of participation will outweigh these challenges.'

Dates and timings for rehearsals to be confirmed. Fees will be around £25 per child per term and will cover essential costs such as teaching, instruments, sheet music, and other equipment. However, there will be financial support for those families that cannot afford this.

Please can I ask that you email school **by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2025** if you are interested in your child participating.
